2018 Board of Directors Election Bios

Jeff Silm - Incumbent

Jeff Silm has been a member of the Credit Union since the late 1970's. He received his BA in Human Resources from Spring Arbor University & has successfully completed numerous Credit Union certificates. He has served on the Credit Committee, Supervisory Committee and has served on the Board since the early 1990's, where he is currently President. Jeff has also served on many other non-profit Boards, including Clinton County Chamber of Commerce, Rotary Club of St. Johns, and Sparrow Clinton Hospital Health Foundation. Jeff believes community service & positive participation on the Board of Directors is vital to the continued growth of the organization.
