Our aim was to ensure that the transaction was based on parity and breakeven from the onset. We are proud to have helped facilitate this historic partnership between two credit unions that share a common vision of serving their members and communities," said Chris Harris, CEO of MiCUSO.

Erika Bauer, CEO of Compass Credit Union, explained that "the intent of JFCU and CCU was never to make money off each other, but rather to improve service to our members." By sharing resources, the two credit unions can offer their members a broader range of financial products and services while reducing costs.

According to Kusler, "the credit union movement has always been about collaboration and helping people. This partnership is just the latest example of that spirit of cooperation."
